On the National Register of Historic Places, **The Ink House** was built in 1885 by Napa Valley, California pioneer Theron Ink as a single-family home. The fully restored property now serves as a modern, sophisticated, boutique inn owned and operated by the charismatic Jean-Charles Boisset and his wife Gina Gallo-Boisset. The duo has added personal touches that highlight first-class amenities and experiences.

An estate manager is available, and able, to make Napa Valley, California travel dreams come true by arranging bespoke wine tastings, exquisite meals prepared by a private chef, and luxurious excursions.
